The Elections Letter details the procedures to nominate NWSEO members for NWSEO offices and to participate in elections for local offices. This year, there will be elections for Regional Chairs and Regional Vice Chairs, as well as Branch Stewards and Vice Stewards, Delegates and Alternate Delegates.

Information for the 2014 National Convention is included in the Elections Letter. All NWSEO members are invited to attend. This year, the 39th annual NWSEO Convention is in Kansas City, Missouri on Sunday and Monday, October 26 - 27, 2014. The convention takes place at the <u>Kansas City Marriott Country Club Plaza</u>.

If you plan to attend the convention, you are responsible for making your reservations. We have successfully negotiated a room rate starting at \$106 per night plus taxes and \$1.74 city room fee. The rate includes complimentary self-parking and wireless guestroom internet. Room reservations must be made by September 27, 2014. They can be booked directly with Marriott by calling 800-810-3708.
