

Make Reservations for the 38th Annual NWSEO Convention

Convention Dates: Sunday-Monday, September 22-23, 2013
Reservations must be made by August 23, 2013

(August 8, 2013) Have you made your reservations yet? The 38th Annual NWSEO Convention is in St. Petersburg, Florida on Sunday and Monday, September 22-23, 2013. The convention takes place at the Vinoy Renaissance St. Petersburg Resort & Golf Club.

We have successfully negotiated a single/double room rate starting at \$93 per night plus 12% tax. Room reservations must be made by August 23, 2013.
